Assistant Development Officer Position

The Kings CED Agency is hiring an Assistant Development Officer under the Youth Internship Program; a partnership with the NS Association of Community Business Development Corporations, Atlantic Canada Opportunities Agency and Nova Scotia Economic and Rural Development. This program gives young people the opportunity to use their skills and acquire new ones in supporting Canada's economic growth through community economic development. The Assistant Development Officer will be required to assist all Development Officers in all areas as required: i.e. research, project development, committee work, preparing and organizing events and meetings, minute taking and other duties as assigned.

The candidates must be between the ages of 18-34 who have graduated from college or university in the field of business or other related disciplines within the last three years and have no previous participation in a work experience program. The candidate must also be currently unemployed, underemployed or employed in an area unrelated to their field of study.

This is a one year term position (35 hours per week). The deadline to apply for this position is by 4:00 p.m. on May 29, 2009.
